

We trust God with all our resources: financial, emotional, societal, and giftings. All we have been given is from God; that is why we give generously, as a tangible way to love God and love people.
















BAPTISM SUNDAYS



This year, your generosity powered \$2,752,706 of meaningful impact throughout our church family and community. With total income of \$2,272,868, we made strategic decisions to invest in the future of Prairie Heights, including the completion of our Lobby Refresh and Rebranding project, a \$275,000 initiative fully funded through savings designated for this purpose through STAND.

Beyond this one-time investment, our ministry operations exceeded regular giving by about \$200,000. This gap reflects our commitment to provide growing programs and staffing that serve both our church family and our community.

We are deeply grateful for the faithfulness and obedience of everyone who gave this year. Your generosity makes every baptism, every life changed, and every moment of worship possible. Prairie Heights continues to flourish because of your generosity, and we are excited to see how God will work through our church family in the year ahead. -Doug Peters, Executive Pastor
